What is a Grade 3 Instructor Rating?

A Grade 3 Flight Instructor Rating allows you to give flying training in all sequences for a Private Pilot License and a Commercial Pilot License.

What are the requirements?

- ✈ Hold a valid Commercial Pilot License or Airline Transport Pilot License
- ✈ Hold a class 1 medical certificate
- ✈ 20 hours of flight instructor patten training conducted by a Grade I or a Grade II Aeroplane Flight Instructor
 - 15 hours dual in an aeroplane
 - 5 hours in an approved FSTD
- ✈ 80 hours one-on-one briefings of which 20 hours will be billed

Exams that you must pass:

- ✈ Applied Meteorology & Navigation
- ✈ Principles of Flight, Legislation & Airmanship
