Student Pilot License (SPL) Requirements

- Must be at least **16 years** of age.
- Hold a class 1 or 2 medical certificate.
- Hold an ICAO language proficiency certificate (if required).
- Completed an aircraft technical.
- Completed an Airlaw exam.
- 2 passport photos.

Private Pilot License (PPL) Requirements

- Must be at least **17 years** old.
- Valid Student Pilot License.
- Hold a restricted or general radiotelephony certificate.
- Completed 8 online PPL exams.
- Accumulate 45 hours total flight time by the end of the course, the 45 hours must include:
 - ≥ 25 dual hours with an instructor
 - ≥ 15 solo hours as PIC
 - ≥ 5 hours cross country PIC
